



## Installation of submarine power cable on ASHTART Field

**WE LISTEN TO YOU, WE PERFORM FOR YOU, WE EVOLVE WITH YOU**

End of February 2013 SAROST accomplished successfully the installation of 2500 m of submarine power cable for the benefit of SEREPT.

Off the Mediterranean coast SAROST's Subaquatic Works and Marine Services Division (DTM) achieved perfectly the electric connection of two offshore platforms by installing 2500 meters of submarine power cable of 12 KV including a line of optic fiber.



The scope and thoroughness of the implementation of the submarine power cable required the mobilization of substantial resources including DP2 vessel equipped with a control pulling cable unit.

The project was carried out in several steps: the design and realization of the two J-Tubes of 65 meters in length which are necessary to receive submarine power cables, were built in the DTM workshops

The installation of these J-tubes on both platforms (ASPF2 & ASPF3) was carried out in water depths up to -60 meters performed by the professional divers and the ROV equipment of SAROST's Subaquatic Works and Marine Services Division.

## ACTIVITIES OF THE SIM

### Network and System Security

Restructuring the system of network security in SAROST

In order to promote the level of SAROST's IT network security, the SIM managed to restructure the system of IT security through the acquisition of new equipment to replace the software ISA Server -2006.

### GMAO Project Launch

Early March the SIM started the project of Managing the Maintenance Assisted by computer. It will enable real-time monitoring of maintenance and stock management of SAROST's mobile and fixed sites (Vessels, FSO, platform Jawhra 5, logistic bases, workshop ...). A significant Qualitative Gap will be created to the completion of this project in 2014.
